Homework - Little and Often!

We will soon be sending your child home with a school reading book. We can't stress enough how important it is to support your child at this early stage in reading, when learning continues at home your child will progress much faster. Please also ensure you sign your child's purple book when you read with them.

As a school we expect you to support your child at home, we are also very aware that the children work very hard during the school day and they may not be very keen to work at home as well. We recommend lots of praise and short 10-15 minute slots when completing reading at home.
