
I am delighted to welcome back all the parents and guardians of children in 5L for Spring 2.

We will be learning about the continent South America and the comparison of physical geography with the UK. We will also be looking at the effects of deforestation has on forests and communities.


To coincide with our learning, we are continuing to read Micheal Morpurgo's 'Running Wild' which the class are enjoying very much.
