

Dear Parents

Year 4 will soon be undertaking their new Challenge Pack entitled Bolts and Bones and in order to support children's learning, we will be visiting the Stoke City's football stadium. On this visit children will go behind the scenes at a premier league stadium and will also get the opportunity to take part in a session run by the Stoke community team in their state of the art Academy Dome.

The trip will take place on Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> November and Children will not need to arrive at school any earlier than their usual time (8:50am) and we will be returning to school by 3:15.

On the visit, children will be required to wear tracksuit bottoms, a jumper (the Dome can be pretty cold) and trainers due to the activity that will be taking place in the Dome. They will also require a packed lunch; this will be provided by the school if your child is entitled to free school meals. Although no spending money is necessary.
