*Challenge: Can we plan a fair to share our Big Science Adventure?*

### Small Dish Challenges

You could chose to complete just 2 of these, or more, or chose 1 to start you off before moving on to a Large Plate Challenge!

Create a self-portrait of yourself as a street child. Work only in pencil and add shade and tone to your drawing.

Write a diary entry using OPV (Other people's views) putting yourself in the role of a street child.

### Large Plate Challenges

You could chose to complete just 1 of these spending a number of weeks on this and building up your learning every time!

Research the role of Barnardo's as a charity from the past and today. What difference have they made to children? Plan an idea for a fundraising activity to support them as a charity.
