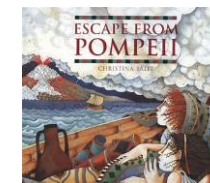
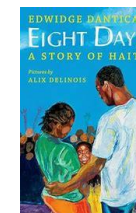

Within English, we will be working alongside our NICER curriculum. We will be looking at writing a diary entry, setting description and story linked to the focus texts we will be using within our challenge packs.

Homework

Maths

Throughout the term, children will be exploring a variety of topics within Maths. These include: Place Value, Addition and Subtraction, Area and Multiplication and Division.

Alongside this, children are encouraged to practice their timestables, which can be accessed on TT Rockstars or a copy of the timestables can be send home on request.

NICER

Our NICER challenge pack this term is 'Catastrophe!'. Within this, Year 4 will be raising awareness for victims and fundraising for charity as their outcome. They will be looking at the impact that natural disasters have on people around the world and how we can best support them.
We will be linking our NICER work to other subjects across the curriculum so that we can widen our understanding.

This term PE lessons will be on a Thursday, children will be working on developing their skills in Basketball and Tag Rugby as well as Dance and Gymnastics with Time4Sport.
