NICER

Our NICER challenge pack this term is 'History Detectives'. The outcome for this challenge pack is to create a museum in a box, so the children will be working on developing their History and Art understanding of who made the earliest changes within Britain. We will be looking at the Stone age to the Iron Age as well as the Romans.

We will be linking our NICER work to other subjects across the curriculum so that we can widen our understanding. Within English, we will be working alongside our NICER curriculum. We will be looking at writing a setting description, a letter, a recount of our hook, a narrative, persuasive writing and a non-chronological report. SPaG focuses will include: prepositions, possessive apostrophes, past tense verbs, persuasive language and suffixes.

Maths

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Throughout the term, children will be exploring a variety of topics within Maths. These include: Multiplication and Division, Length and Perimeter, Fractions and Decimals.

Alongside this, children are encouraged to practice their timestables, which can be accessed on TT Rockstars or a copy of the timestables can be send home on request.

P.E

This term PE lessons will be on a Thursday, children will be working on developing their skills in Fitness, Gymnastics and Tennis. Children are reminded to bring appropriate kit. Details can be found on our school website. A polite reminder that football shirts are not to be worn during PE.

R.E

This term in RE, we will be focusing on 'For Christians, what was the impact of Pentecost?'. In Spring 2, we will be focusing on 'Why do Christians call the day Jesus died Good Friday?'.
