NICER

This term, the children's challenge pack is "The Power of Words". The children will be working towards creating their own own ibook, including a range of genres. Based on the power of Greta Thunberg's words and actions, the children will study the impact that people's choices are having upon the environment, the changes that take place as a result and the impact upon physical and human geography of studied areas. Children will investigate the power of art to reflect words and messages looking at the work of artists such of Banksy, Jean-Michel Basquiat, looking at techniques used (street art/graffiti/photographs/mixed media) They will take inspiration to create their own powerful class or individual message.

English

In English, children will be writing story narratives based on their class text, focusing on how to build tension. As you might guess from our challenge pack we will be focusing on the impact word words and expanding their vocabulary and experimenting with different sentence structure to make our writing so that it impacts the reader.

Maths

In mathematics, we will continue to practise our most effective methods (mental and written) for all four calculation methods we have learnt during the Autumn term – this will also include calculation methods involving fractions.

We will also study ratio, algebra along with decimals and percentages.

Please support your child to learn the timestables to 12×12 and numberbond fact with instant recall. This will support their fluency and help when they are solving challenging calculations.
